For Teen & child DVDs

\$0.50 per item, per day

Avoid fines on library materials by returning them
on time with the help of these tips:

Check Your Account online to track due dates

or call Answerline (416-393-7131) to check the status
of your account

Keep your receipts handy

and mark your due dates on your calendar

Remember to renew

unless someone else requests an item, you can renew
most items twice
